

**Notice on Charging New Fees for Statutory Certificates and Documents in the
Name of the Panama Maritime Authority**

Relevant shipping companies:

According to PMA's Board of Directors Resolution J.D. No. 002-2010, Recognized organizations are required to charge fees of statutory certificates and documents on behave of the Panama Maritime Authority since 22 August 2010.

(1) Charge of US\$75.00 for approval, issuance, re-issuance, change of name or any modification in the details of each of, including but not limited to, the following full term certificates issued by Recognized organizations in the name of the Panama Maritime Authority:

1. Passenger Ship Safety Certificate (Passenger Vessels) ;
2. Safety Construction Certificate (Cargo Vessels) ;
3. Safety Equipment Certificate (Cargo Vessels) ;
4. Safety Radio Certificate (Cargo Vessels of 1600 GT and over) ;
5. Safety Radio Certificate (Cargo Vessels of 300 GT and upwards, but less than 1600 GT) ;
6. International Load Line Certificate (Passenger and Cargo Vessels) ;
7. Document of Authorization for the Carriage of Grain (where applicable) ;
8. International Oil Pollution Prevention Certificate (MARPOL) ;
9. Mobile Offshore Drilling Unit Safety Certificate;
10. International Certificate of Fitness for the Carriage of Dangerous Chemicals in Bulk, or International Pollution Prevention Certificate for the Carriage of Noxious Liquid Substances in Bulk;
11. Certificate of Fitness for the Carriage of Dangerous Chemicals in Bulk ;
12. International Certificate of Fitness for the Carriage of liquefied Gas in Bulk ;

13. Certificate of Fitness for the Carriage of liquefied Gas in Bulk ;
14. Pleasure Craft Safety Certificate;
15. Document of Compliance ;
16. Safety Management Certificate ;
17. Document of Authorization for the Carriage of dangerous goods;
18. High Speed Craft Safety Certificate ;
19. Cargo Ship Safety Certificate (for Vessels under 500 GT) ;
20. Fishing Vessel Safety Certificate ;
21. Condition Assessment Scheme (CAS) ;
22. International Sewage Pollution Prevention Certificate (ISPP) ;
23. International Air Pollution Prevention Certificate (IAPP) ;
24. International Certificate of Fitness for the Carriage of Nuclear Fuel
in Bulk ;
25. Nuclear Passenger Ship Safety Certificate ;
26. Nuclear Cargo Ship Safety Certificate ;
27. Special Purpose Ship Safety Certificate ;
28. International Certificate of Anti-fouling System.

Charge US \$50.00 for the intermediate or annual endorsement of the above certificates issued by Recognized organizations in the name of the Panama Maritime Authority.

(2) Charge of US\$50.00 for approval, issuance, re-issuance, endorsement, change of name or any modification in the details of each of, including but not limited to, the following supplements and plans issued by Recognized organizations, either annual, intermediate or at its relevant time, in the name of the Panama Maritime Authority:

1. Shipboard Marine Pollution Emergency Plan of noxious liquid substances;
2. Cargo Securing Manual;
3. Intact Stability Booklet;
4. Damage Stability Booklet;

5. Ship Oil Pollution Emergency Plan (SOPEP);
6. Garbage Management Plan;
7. Ship Security Plan;
8. Fight Control Plan;
9. Damage Control Plan;
10. Procedures and Arrangement Plan;
11. Grain Loading Manual;
12. Nuclear Ship Operation Manual;
13. Search and Rescue Manual;
14. Enhanced Survey Program (ESP).
