Notice on the implementation of St. Vincent and the Grenadines Circular PSC 032 Rev.1-Actions to be taken on St. Vincent and the Grenadines' vessels in view of PSC inspections

The Maritime Administration of St. Vincent and the Grenadines issued the Circular N° PSC 032 Rev.1 on November 07, 2018. Compared with the old version, this circular adjusts the applicable ship subject, which means all vessels subject to PSC Inspections, AND Pre-Arrival checklist is not applicable for the vessels engaged on voyages in the Caribbean Region. Accordingly, this notice is to revise "Notice on the implementation of St. Vincent and the Grenadines Circular PSC 032-Actions to be taken on St. Vincent and the Grenadines' vessels in view of PSC inspections" by CCS (Total No.150), other contents refer to the original circular. CCS auditors should verify the implementation of the circular during the ISM audits (DOC and SMC). The new requirement will enter into force from the issue date of the circular, i.e. November 07, 2018.
