session of IMO Marine Environment Protection Committee

The seventy-four session of the Marine Environment Protection Committee was held at IMO Headquarters from 13 to 17 May 2019. The meeting mainly reviewed following items, consideration and adoption of amendments to mandatory instruments, harmful aquatic organisms in ballast water, air pollution and energy efficiency, further technical and operational measures for enhancing the energy efficiency of international shipping, reduction of GHG emissions from ships, action plan to address marine plastic litter from ships, pollution prevention and response, and other important matters.

This meeting adopted/approved 24 technical documents, including resolutions and circulars. The list of relevant documents adopted/approved is attached in annex 1, and the specific resolutions and circular texts are attached in annex 2.
