Notice on CCS Certification Service of Hong Kong Registered Ships in Accordance with International Convention on Civil Liability for Bunker Oil Pollution Damage, 2001

1 General Introduction

International Convention on Civil Liability for Bunker Oil Pollution Damage, 2001(hereinafter referred to as "the Bunker Convention") has come into force since 21 November 2008. The Bunker Convention Certificate shall be issued in accordance with the Article 7 of the Convention, as follows: the registered owner of a ship having a gross tonnage greater than 1,000 registered in a State Party shall be required to maintain insurance or other financial security, such as the guarantee of a bank or similar financial institution, to cover the liability of the registered owner for pollution damage in an amount equal to the limits of liability. A certificate attesting that insurance or other financial security is in force in accordance with the provisions of this Convention shall be issued to ships after the appropriate authority of a State Party (or its RO) has determined that the requirements of this Convention have been complied with. This certificate shall be in the form of the model set out in the annex to the Convention. With respect to a ship registered in a State Party such certificate shall be issued or certified by the appropriate authority of the State of the ship's registry; with respect to a ship not registered in a State Party it may be issued or certified by the appropriate authority of any State Party. The certificate shall be carried on board the ship and a copy shall be deposited with the authorities who keep the record of the ship's registry or, if the ship is not registered in a State Party, with the authorities issuing or certifying the certificate. For detailed provisions, please refer to the Convention.

Hong Kong SAR Government acceded to the Convention and brought it into force to ships registered in Hong Kong on 22 January 2010. According to the formal notice dated 23 February 2010 which sent by Marine Department of Hong Kong, the Administration authorized CCS to issue the "Certificate of Insurance or Other Financial Security in Respect of Civil Liability for Bunker Oil Pollution Damage", in accordance with the provision of article 7(3) of the Bunker Convention, to Hong Kong registered ships since 19 May 2010.

To facilitate shipping companies for those who have ships flying Hong Kong flag to apply for the Bunker Convention Certificate, the processes and relevant requirements should be informed as follows:

2 Definitions and Abbreviation

2.1 "Ship": unless otherwise specified, means any Hong Kong registered ships which are regulated by the Bunker Convention.

2.2 "**Shipping Company**": means any shipping management company that managed ships as defined in 2.1 of this Circular.

2.3 "**The Bunker Convention Certificate**": means "Certificate of Insurance or Other Financial Security in Respect of Civil Liability for Bunker Oil Pollution Damage" as required by article 7 of the Bunker Convention.

2.4 "**Shipowner** (definition of the Convention)": means the owner, including the registered owner, bareboat charterer, manager and operator of the ship.

2.5 "**Registered Owner** (definition of the Convention)" means the person or persons registered as the owner of the ship or, in the absence of registration, the person or persons owning the ship. However, in the case of a ship owned by a State and operated by a company which in that State is registered as the ship's operator, "registered owner" shall mean such company.

2.6 "The Branch" means CCS Hong Kong Branch.

3 Acceptance of Application

3.1 CCS Hong Kong Branch is designated for acceptance of all applications for the issuance of the Bunker Convention Certificate submitted by the shipping companies. The contact information of Hong Kong Branch is as follows:

4 Submitting Application

4.1 The shipping company who intends to apply for the issuance of the Bunker Convention Certificate shall be responsible for maintaining insurance or other financial security, which shall be supplied by the insurance company/banking institution that the Administration approves*, in force in accordance with the provisions of the Convention. Note:* the list of insurance companies/banking institutions that the Administration approves up till February, 2010 is attached as Annex 4 for reference.

4.2 The shipping company shall submit following application documents by E-mail, fax or courier to CCS Hong Kong Branch: (It is highly recommended that the applicant send the application document via E-mail in order to facilitate succeeding process)

- (1) The applicant must use CCS specific application form (Form AFC-CBK(HKG) which attached as Annex 2) and make sure every item of the form has been finished completely, accurately and clearly. The application shall be endorsed and/or stamped by the authorized personnel.
- (2) Scanning/copy of the insurance certificate/blue card or other financial security.
- (3) Scanning/copy of Ship registration certificate.
- (4) Any other documents (if any).

4.3 The shipping company shall guarantee the submitted documents (i.e. copies/scanning of ship insurance certificate/financial guarantee certificate and ship's registration certificate), on the basis of which the bunker convention certificate is issued, are completely consistent with the original one and are real effective. The shipping company shall also guarantee the payment for the issuance of the certificate. For the sake of avoiding any possible delay to the operation of the ship, shipping companies are advised to notice CCS as quickly as possible and apply for re-issuance of the certificate when necessary provided that there is any change to parameters indicated on the certificate.

5 Issuing Certificate

5.1 The Branch after receive the application and other applicable documents submitted by the applicant, shall verify those documents including application, insurance certificate/financial guarantee of ship, registration certificate and so on, and highly focus on the complete and accuracy of the information of the ship and its company. The insurance /guarantee shall comply with requirements of the Convention.

5.2 After verifying the submitted document, the Branch shall issue "Certificate of Insurance or other Financial Security in Respect of Civil Liability for Bunker Oil Pollution Damage" (Form CBK(HKG), Annex 3). The validity of the certificate shall not exceed the validity of the insurance or other financial guarantee.

5.3 The branch shall deliver the original and a copy of the certificate, attached with the invoice to the applicant. Meanwhile, an electronic copy of the certificate will be send to the Marine Department of Hong Kong within one month as per the requirement.

6 Fee of the Certification

6.1 For CCS classed ships, 100 US dollars per ship (including one original and one copy of the certificate) will be charged; for non-CCS classed ships, 200 US dollars per ship (including one original and one copy of the certificate) will be charged accordingly.

6.2 In addition, 60 US dollars per ship of communication and postage expenses will be charged.

This Circular will come into force on 19 MAY 2010. All CCS branches are requested to forward this Circular to the shipowners and ship management companies for those who have ships flying Hong Kong flag.

International Convention on Civil Liability for Bunker Oil Pollution Damage, 2001 (Bunkers Convention)-Authorization to China Classification Society
