A notice of definition of shipyard in regulation and its implemented requirement

1. Definition of shipyard

Notice of variable situation arising in the actual newbuilding site, as mentioned in chapter 4, newbuilding survey, Rules for the Classification of Sea-going Steel Ships, issued by CCS; as well as in both, Rules for Classification of Domestic Sea-going Ships, and the Rules for Classification of Inland River-going Ships, the definition of “shipyard” will be presented as following

Shipyard is also known as shipbuilder, which is the place for signing contracts and building the ships. When using the working site, facilitates, or personnel owned by other shipyards, the shipyard should shoulder its responsibilities to the producing organization, working design, original material and equipment supply, quality control, personnel management, technical training, newbuilding standard, quality acceptance, and producing technology, may also issue a statement when present the application of newbuilding survey.

2. Implement requirement

- 1) The applicator must inform the actual newbuilding site when present the application; blocks, pipes, and outfitting are excluded.
- 2) When using the working site, facilitates, or personnel owned by other shipyards, the shipyard should shoulder its responsibilities to the producing organization, working design, original material and equipment supply, quality control, personnel management, technical training, newbuilding standard, quality acceptance, and producing technology, may also issue a statement when present the application of newbuilding survey.

- 3) The shipbuilder involved in the certificate and report is the one defined by this circular.
- 4) “Place of build” was added to RH report and marine ship first survey record (Form JLYH), in which should be filled with the address of actual newbuilding site of this ship.
- 5) When using the working site, facilitates, or personnel owned by other shipyards, ships build with same drawing in different working site cannot be regarded as sister ships.
