AMSA PSC Focused Inspection Activities

AMSA is looking at paying particular focus on areas such as the effectiveness of maintenance on main engines and power generation systems.

Recent incidents have demonstrated the potentially serious consequences of a lack of effective maintenance of main engines and power generation systems that can pose serious risks to the safe and pollution-free operation of vessels.

AMSA will immediately increase its focus on planned maintenance during routine Port State Control inspections of the propulsion and auxiliary equipment and associated systems and will take necessary compliance actions to address any identified areas of concern.

To support this, CCS surveyors will likely be an increase in physical attendance to verify the condition of critical equipment and its suitability to continue to meet convention requirements.

It should be remembered that this is not envisaged as a Focused Inspection Campaign or a Concentrated Inspection Campaign. It is a permanent change in AMSA procedures and will be ongoing.
